- *Each music student is committed to 8 lessons per term.*
- *Each music student is required to be a member of a school ensemble and attend all rehearsals and performances. Please note ensembles can take place before and after school as well as during lunchtime.*
- *When cancelling lessons due to illness, the Performing Arts Office needs to be notified by calling 9331 9121 BEFORE 8:00am in order to receive a makeup lesson. Students are to notify teachers in regards to timetable clashes with excursions at least one week prior to their lesson date. Assessments or other special events need two school days' notice prior to their lesson.*
- *Students are scheduled to come out of a 75 minute class to attend Private Music lessons, usually for half an hour. Lessons are scheduled on a rotating timetable so that students are not missing the same subject each week.*
- *Each student must bring their instrument and music to school when required. Instruments can be left in the Music Storage Room. Home practice is part of school homework and should be completed every day.*
- *Direct Debit or Credit Card option form must be returned with this Registration form.*
- *To withdraw from lessons, four weeks' notice before the end of the term must be given to the Performing Arts Office. Withdrawal from Private Music lessons form and specific withdrawal dates can be located on the school's website on the Co-curricular page.*
- *Enrolment in the Instrumental Program is ongoing. Students must follow the withdrawal process outlined above to discontinue lessons at any time, including at the end of a school year. Students do not have to re-enrol in lessons from year to year once they have signed up to the program.*
